Records to be kept on usage and location in pest control master file.
Operator to wear suitable PPE when handling. Including gloves. Records of PPE maintenance to be held centrally
Waste product to be retained and disposed of by Pest Control operator as per EA guidelines.
Do not open sachets and use in tamper resistant boxes only
