State the Risks to Health from Identified Hazards

EC Classification:

R50 / 53 - Very toxic to aquatic organism, may cause long term adverse effects in the aquatic environment.
R11 – Highly Flammable

Control Measures:

Always read label / MSDS before use and comply with details.

Remove non-target organisms / People during application

Keep in original, labelled container.

Remain in control of substance at all times. Storage to be restricted to certified store, out of storage use to be confined to regulated vehicle.

Cover fish tanks and water tanks before application

Do not contaminate foodstuffs, utensils, utensils or food contact surfaces

Where risk of interception by 3rd party warning labels to be used to denote use and risk.

Keep away from source of ignition, naked flame

Records to be kept on usage in pest control master file.
 Operator to wear suitable PPE when handling and applying As detailed below. Records of PPE maintenance to be held centrally.
 Waste product to be retained and disposed of by Pest Control operator as per EA guidelines. Do not pierce or burn canister even when empty.









Safety Phrases:

First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Move the exposed person to fresh air. Obtain medical advice immediately

Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash off immediately with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists obtain medical attention. Contaminated clothing should be washed and dried before re-use.

Eyes: May cause eye irritation of susceptible persons. Rinse immediately with plenty of water for 15 Mins holding the eyelids open. If irritation persists obtain medical attention.

Ingestion: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITTING. If conscious give a small amount of water to drink and obtain medical attention. Show the container label or safety sheet to the doctor.

Storage / Spillage

Storage: Keep in original labelled container, out of reach of children and non-target species. Protected from elements. Keep container tightly closed in a dry cool and well-ventilated place. keep away from sources of ignition

Spillage – Clean spillages immediately. Avoid entry to watercourses
